HOW TO BUILT A PET BOTTLE PURSE ...

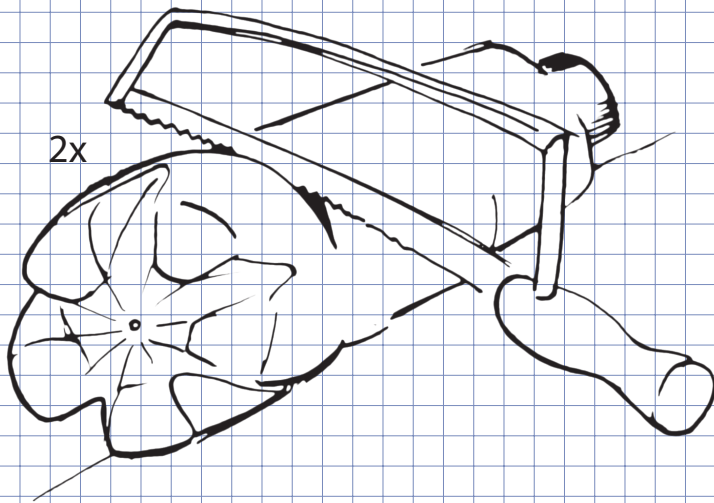
Following this introduction you can build a „PET Bottle Purse“ out of two bottoms of PET bottles and a zipper. You can either use the box as purse or as storage-box.
Do not scale document when printing!

Stuff you need:

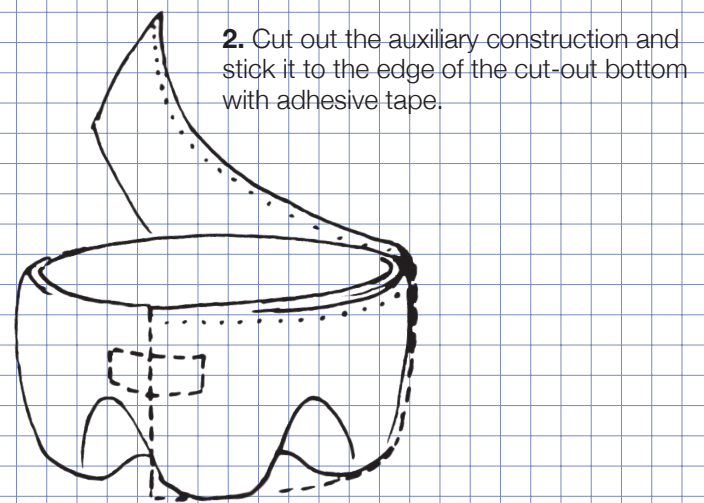
- 2 empty PET bottles 0,5 l
- 1 zipper (20 cm)
- a Nylon thread

Tools you need:

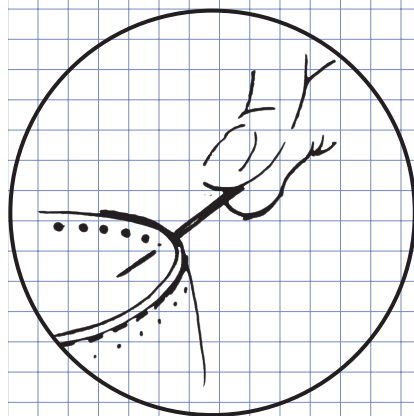
- a knife, and a small pair of scissors
- a thin needle, a thick sharp needle or a hole-punch
- adhesive tape



1. Cut out the bottoms of the PET bottles at approximately 2,5 cm, afterwards finish with small sissor.

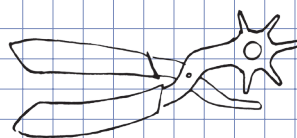


2. Cut out the auxiliary construction and stick it to the edge of the cut-out bottom with adhesive tape.

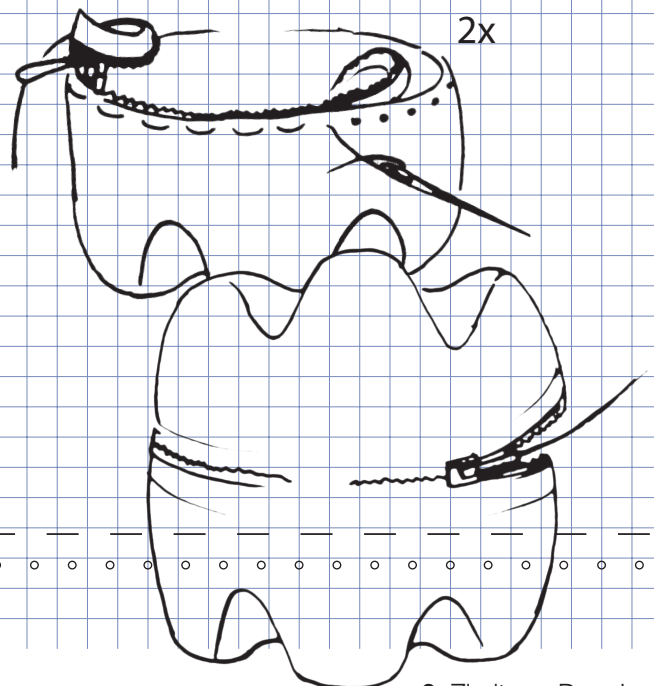


3. Use the thick needle or the hole-punch to pierce the bottom where the auxiliary construction marks the stitching-holes with dots.

4. Remove auxiliary construction.



5. Pass the nylon thread through the eye of the thin needle and sew the zipper all around the first bottom and back. Repeat the procedure with the second bottom.



6. Zip it up. Done!
